Sherlock Seattle Rules for Minors

A minor as defined by the State of Washington is any child* under the age of 18. Minors 15 and under must have a parent, legal guardian, or an individual designated by the parent or legal guardian, on-site when the minor is on-site. (See PERMISSION SLIP FOR MINORS)

Minors age 16 & 17 must have an emergency contact form on file with Registration (See Section Below) signed by a parent or legal guardian before being allowed to attend the convention without a parent or legal guardian. In the event that the parent or legal guardian is not available at the time this form is presented to Registration, said parent or legal guardian will be contacted to ensure that the information is correct.
